PRINCE OF PEACE

Matthew 10:34-36 *"Do not suppose that I have come to bring peace to the earth. I did not come to bring peace, but a sword. For I have come to turn "a man against his father, a daughter against her mother, a daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law—a man's enemies will be the members of his own household."*

John 10:10 *"The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy;"*

Galatians 5:19-21 *"The acts of the sinful nature are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like. I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God."*

Romans 8:5-8 *"Those who live according to the sinful nature have their minds set on what that nature desires; but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the Spirit desires. The mind of sinful man is death, but the mind controlled by the Spirit is life and peace; the sinful mind is hostile to God. It does not submit to God's law, nor can it do so."*

Isaiah 48:22 *"There is no peace," says the LORD, "for the wicked."*

Isaiah 57:21 *"There is no peace," says my God, "for the wicked."*

Isaiah 59:7-8 *"The way of peace they do not know; there is no justice in their paths. They have turned them into crooked roads; no one who walks in them will know peace."*

Psalms 119:165 *"Great peace have they who love your law, and nothing can make them stumble."*

Proverbs 3:13,17 *"Blessed is the man who finds wisdom, the man who gains understanding . . . Her ways are pleasant ways, and all her paths are peace."*

John 10:10 *"The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life and have it to the full."*

Philippians 4:6-9 *"Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.
