**Note:** What this questionnaire calls exorcism should biblically, properly, be referred to as <u>deliverance ministry</u>. The ability to stand in God's name and in His place of authority and to declare that any and all demons or demonic forces affecting a person, situation, or possession be cast out into the deepest sea never to return. That as the person with this gift stands in Jesus place of authority the demonic force(s) <u>must</u> obey.
